

UPDATE Romania: e-transport / Extension of the obligations to obtain UIT codes

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

As a supplement to our information letter from 12th June 2024, we are announcing the following changes to the RO e-Transport legislation:

The applicable thresholds for the application of the RO e-Transport system above which a UIT code must be obtained are **for transports with a vehicle >2.5 tonnes, freight weight/per consignment >500 kg gross and/or goods value >=10,000 lei (approx. EUR 2,000)**

Furthermore, the transport of goods by postal service providers in postal parcels, as defined in the Government Emergency Ordinance No. 13/2013 on postal services, is exempt from the reporting obligation. Currently, the legislation stipulates that a postal parcel is a postal item with a maximum weight of 31.5kg containing goods with or without commercial value. This must be reviewed regularly, as the parcel weight may be subject to change.

The exception applies if the following conditions are cumulatively fulfilled:

- the goods are transported as a postal parcel and
- the carrier is an authorised postal service provider and
- the weight of the parcel is < 31.5 kg

Exceptionally, the provisions of Article LXXIV(21) will only enter into force **on 1 January 2025** for the aforementioned Romanian responsible persons who have the status of **authorised economic operator (AEO)** at the time of the cross-border transport of goods.

The sanctions provided for in the legislation will therefore be applied, as announced, from 1 July 2024 to all users of the RO e-Transport system, **with the exception of authorised economic operators (AEO)**, who will therefore be sanctioned from 1 January 2025.
